Dear Parents/Carers

Happy New Year and welcome to the beginning of our Spring term 2022! I hope you all had a relaxing Christmas break and enjoyed some well-deserved family time together.



You would have received the school's updated risk assessment for this term. Apologies for the continual updates, but as you can appreciate things are changing rapidly. I will continue to keep you updated as new information is received. The latest guidance states that from next Tuesday 11th January, anyone who tests positive on a lateral flow can self-isolate without needing to take a PCR test. Those who develop covid symptoms are required to self-isolate and take a PCR test. Please see full government updates here:

We have a full range of after school clubs arranged for our children this term, many of which will begin next week from 3-4pm. Before the end of term, we sent out a letter to gauge interest in an after-school music club for Years 1 and 2. Due to other commitments, we are looking to reschedule this to Wednesday 3-4pm. There will be a cost of £3.45 per session for these lessons, and **we will only be able to run the club if we have enough interest**. We endeavour to get these lessons up and running within the next few weeks.

Unfortunately, due to the high levels of Covid, we are unable to invite parents into school for our weekly celebration assemblies or book and biscuit sessions. We hope it won't be too long before things are safe enough to have our parents back into school.

Over this half term, staff will be reviewing the targets set for children and updating these to share with parents. Next week alongside our newsletter, parents will receive a termly curriculum newsletter. This will include the knowledge organisers that teachers will be sharing with the children for our wider curriculum subjects. We hope that you will be able to support your child/ren with the curriculum at home.

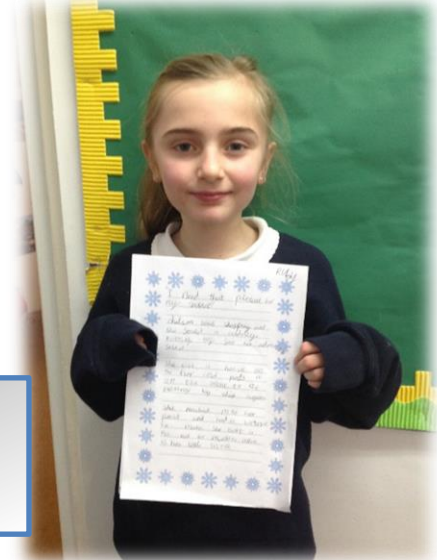
