Goodbye and Good Luck

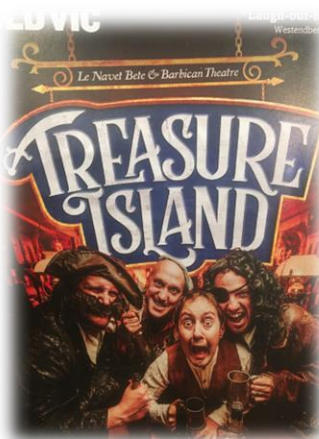
