Dear parents & carers,

Just to remind everyone that the children at Boasley Cross will be spending the day at Northlew Primary school this Monday for our space dome visit. 
been learning. Watch this space for details!




Forest School

Several of the children in Oketor Class have read or are reading this book and have expressed how much it has helped them to understand their own thoughts and feelings


