We had a lot of fun learning about distributing our weight evenly. Yesterday we used Newton meters to measure weight and force. We compared the amount of force

shown when an object hung from the bottom with the amount of force needed to pull it across a table. Take a look at the following pictures. Our DT project is all about adapting a recipe. We have tasted different Bolognese sauces and chosen ingredients to use in our own versions. Some of them sound very interesting! We
