Our focus this term is resilience, and a certificate will be a awarded each week for a child in each class demonstrating this value. A 'Super Learner' certificate will also be awarded to a child in each class who has been showing great determination and trying their best with their learning.

Last term on our transition day, Mrs Winter spoke to children about exploring a new name for the K52 class. The children liked the idea of something local and so have come up with the name 'Oketor'.

I am so proud how all the children have settled and the great teamwork they have demonstrated in the learning challenges they have been set this week. The children have been taking part in various activities in the classroom; including setting their own classroom rules and behaviour expectations which they have been following fantastically this week!
