Dear Parents/Carers,

At the end of our third week of term, the children are fully emerged in our curriculum. I have seen lots of interaction and excitement for learning; the children listening carefully to the adults and each other, supporting one another to be the best they can be and being ready, respectful and safe.

The children have demonstrated their resilience this week in all aspects of school life, and we have been exploring the phase 'I haven't got it yet' rather than 'I can't do this' or 'I'm stuck'. They have been using their subject knowledge and previous learning to make connections with new learning challenges and enthusiasm and engagement has been excellent across the school.

It is lovely to welcome our parents to our weekly celebration assembly this week. Our celebration assemblies are an opportunity to highlight those children who have demonstrated our school value of resilience and fantastic learning this week. We would also welcome children to bring along achievements and successes from outside school too (e.g., sporting achievements, charity work etc.).

Today we announced our new school leadership team for the year. They will be fully emerged in their roles starting from next week, and we are keen to hear the ideas they would like to bring to their new responsibilities. Mrs Ogborne will be leading the school council and Ethos group who will meet each week. I will be meeting with our librarians every Monday at breaktime and sports leaders each Monday at lunchtime. Our meetings will give the children the opportunity to share ideas and plan what they would like to do for the year ahead. We are looking forward to welcoming the children to their roles and working closely together to achieve the best for everyone in our school.

Our book and biscuit afternoons will begin next week at 2:15pm - 2:35pm and continue fortnightly. Parents are welcome into school to read with their child/ren, with plenty of biscuits for everyone. After the book and biscuit morning, parents are then welcome to stay for our weekly celebration assembly.

As the weather and seasons are changing, can we ask that all children bring a coat to school each day. Our EYFS children spend a lot of time outside in our continuous provision, so a coat is essential for those colder days. Full PE kits (white t-shirt, navy shorts and trainers) are needed for our PE sessions each Thursday in Littlemoor class and Friday in Oketor class.

Finally, as mentioned in last week's newsletter we would like to welcome all our parents for an afternoon picnic on  $4^{th}$  October to celebrate the grand opening of our new forest school shelter which was kindly rebuilt by Mr Morris over the summer holidays. Please could you contact the school office by the end of the school day on Monday  $27^{th}$  September to let us know if you are able to come so that we can arrange the catering for the event.





