

Bodmin class (KS2) – Termly overview Spring 2019 – Mr Paine

History

- Pupils will be taught about the achievements of early civilisations. Bodmin will provide an overview of where and when the first civilisations appeared and an in depth study of Ancient Egypt.

English: Core text studied this term include - Shadow Child. Other texts are to be decided later on in the term.

In these ten tales of the supernatural. Philippa Pearce gives ordinary incidents and objects of everyday life a threatening, frightening power. Philippa Pearce is one of the greatest children's writers of the 20th century and her sharp imagination shines through the stories within this core text. Daily spelling, punctuation and grammar (SPaG) sessions will also be taught - these SPaG sessions form a pivotal part of English lessons and are essential for Y5 and Y6 children.

Furthermore, guided reading lessons will take place daily. These sessions will look to give children the knowledge and ability to pull apart texts, developing the comprehension skills necessary to tackle assessments in the year.

RE/ PHSE/ CITIZENSHIP:

Values based teaching in RE/ PSHE sessions as well as learning based on Christian and other traditions and festivals.



SCIENCE: Forces

- Explain that unsupported objects fall towards the earth because of the force of gravity acting between the earth and the falling object.
- Identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction which act between moving surfaces.
- Recognise that some mechanisms, including levers, pulleys and gears, allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.
