

Personal, Social, Emotional Development:

Throughout the autumn term we will be thinking about 'New Beginnings' and getting to know the other children in Littlemoor. We will look at the qualities of being a good friend and how we can show kindness to each other. We will also be focusing on the Boasley Cross golden rules throughout the term. We will observe and record the children's progress in their Learning Journal.

Literacy:

To develop our reading and writing skills we will begin linking letters and sounds through daily phonics sessions. The children will have opportunities to explore books within the classroom and within our school library. Writing opportunities will be available within the children's play.



Understanding the World:

We will be learning to explore the environment around us through play. We will be talking about some of the things we have observed such as plants, animals and natural objects. Following this, we will be observing changes across the four seasons and describing weather associated with the seasons.



Communication and Language:

This term we will be using language to imagine and re-create roles and experiences in play. Following on from exploring books on a daily basis we will also be encouraging children to use stories and narratives in their play. Through the use of peer and whole class work the children will continue to develop their language.

Expressive Art and Design:

In art and design, we will be developing a wide range of art and design techniques including using pattern and texture.

In music, we will be using our voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.



Mathematics:

In Maths we will be developing our counting skills using our fingers, objects, numicon and through counting songs. We will also be learning to recognise numbers and focusing on a different number each week.



Physical Development:

In PE, we will be mastering basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination. We will also be strengthening our fingers and arms ready for writing, through fine motor activities.
