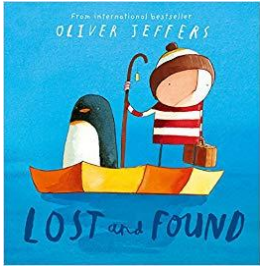


## HISTORY/ GEOGRAPHY:

History - We will look at the lives of significant individuals in the past (for example Elizabeth 1, Queen Victoria, Christopher Columbus, Nelson Mandela, Florence Nightingale).

Geography - Locational and place knowledge - name and locate the world's 7 continents and 5 oceans; name, locate and identify characteristics of the 4 countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas; understand geographical similarities and differences through studying the human and physical geography of a small area of the United Kingdom, and of a small area in a contrasting non-European country.

**ENGLISH:** Core texts studied this term include:



Daily Guided Reading sessions as well as peer reading will continue. We will focus on storytelling and ORACY through sharing ideas on varied texts in all subjects. Systematic Phonics teaching is daily as well as morning handwriting practice. Reading comprehension is a focus this term.

**RE/PHSE:** We will be looking at friendship and what makes a good friend as well as dealing with our emotions as they change. There is a visit from Daya early in the term which will inspire RE learning on Islam.



## SCIENCE: Animals including humans

Pupils will notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults; find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air); describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

## ART/ MUSIC/ DT:

ART: In Littlemoor, we will be using a variety of artists' materials to express emotion and colour. We will focus on the seasons and changing landscape.

MUSIC: Pitch and rhythm will be explored as well as lots of singing! Mrs Joliffe will deliver weekly Music lessons as our Music specialist. This term we have the drums to explore rhythm and percussion.

**MATHS:** In Maths, we will be covering the following areas this term:

- Using mathematical language
