Dear Parents/Carers,

10<sup>th</sup> January 2022

Following the Government changes to testing for Covid that come into place from tomorrow, I would like to outline those changes and what it means for us at School.

### **Testing positive on Lateral flow from Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> January**

- If your child or a member of your household tests positive on a lateral flow from 11<sup>th</sup> January 2022, you are no longer required to carry out a PCR test, but instead isolate for 7/10 days and continue to take a lateral flow test daily
- Children and staff members can return to school/work on day 7 following a negative lateral flow test on days 6 and 7 of isolation, providing your child is not displaying any symptoms
- Please confirm with the school office asap if your child or a member of your household has tested positive on a lateral flow.
- Children can attend school when members of the household have tested positive on a lateral flow (providing they are not displaying any symptoms) but they must carry out daily lateral flows for the next 7 days
- Please do not send your child to school if they are displaying any Covid related symptoms, (high temperature, new or continuous cough and sore throat)
- If your child displays symptoms whilst at school, we will contact parents to collect child and carry out a lateral flow at home (particularly if there is currently a positive case within the household). Children should stay at home and self-isolate if they test positive on their lateral flow or if their symptoms persist.

### **Access to learning whilst isolating:**

- If your child is isolating and is unable to attend school, learning will be available on the class dojo site for them to access at home

- This learning will help to support your child to make a smooth transition with their return to school and to explore the learning currently covered in the classroom
- If you need support to access the learning on the class dojo, please contact the school office
